



Troy Elder OAM, played for the All Blacks Hockey Club. Nicknamed Woody, Elder shot into limelight as a player with the National Junior Squad, that won the Hockey Junior World Cup at Milton Keynes in 1997 against India. After the 1998 Australian Hockey League season with the Queensland Blades, Elder got into the senior National Squad at the 1998 Champions Trophy in Lahore, where Australia won the bronze. He was part of the winning team in the 1999 Champions Trophy at Brisbane.

Troy played 169 games for Australia, with 104 goals. He was a member of the Men's National Team that won the golden medal at the 2004 Summer Olympics in Athens. Four years earlier, when Sydney hosted the Olympic Games, Elder finished in third spot with The Kookaburras.

Troy is currently the Captain/coach of the Bulimba Bulls, where in 2015 he was named Brisbane Hockey League Player of the Year and in 2016 his team the Bulimba Bulls won the Brisbane Hockey Grand Final and Troy was awarded Coach of the Year.
